Newbrook Wesleyan Standard Church, Bus Rider Code of Conduct, Behavior expectations:

1. Respect the bus driver, bus volunteers, and other bus riders at all times
2. Stay in your seat and keep your head, hands and feet to yourself at all time.
3. No yelling or screaming, avoid the use of foul language, name calling, etc.
4. No fighting for any reason- this will result in an immediate suspension of bus riding privileges
5. Do not throw objects in or out of the bus
